For curriculum officials to analyse and profile the subject at risk of underperforming in the coming term.

What documents are needed?

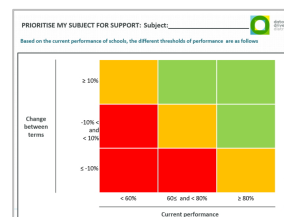


What are the outcomes of the subject profiling tool?

- This profile results in a **9 block matrix to categorise the subject by schools**, based on learner achievement.
- A clear picture of the **subject's performance** and a profile of the educator performance for this subject.



- Follow the steps outlined in the **subject profiling tool**.
- **Gather data** off the Dashboard and answer the subject analysis questions to gain insights into how curriculum is performing in the district.



The subject profiling tool can be used to profile subjects **four times in the year**. Once profiling is concluded, use this document as a management tool during school visits and intervention planning.

When profiling the subject, it is a good idea to refer to the curriculum elements of the School Improvement Plan and ensure that the plans align.
