- In preparation for the school visit, you will determine the agenda (focus areas) for the visit. This agenda will be shared with the principal prior to the visit.
- To complete the preparation, use the checklist in conjunction with the Dashboard to check the progress the school is making in their interventions.







How do I use this



- Have this data at your finger tips during the school visit.
- Discuss with the principal the focus area what have they done? What has worked well? What are some of the challenges they face? What are the results showing?
- Use the Dashboard data as either a baseline metric or a progress metric depending on the extent to which the intervention has been rolled out.
